## ***You're invited to exhibit at our 'Family Gathering'***

For the first time, Platform Presents is bringing its multi-arts experience to Sydney/Eora as part of Asian Heritage Week, led by Asian Hustle Network. While the week is not yet formally recognised nationwide, it remains an important moment for us to come together. It's a chance to honour our histories, amplify voices and recognise the depth of creative practices across our communities.

This three-day pop-up brings together artists of the Asian diaspora for a shared presentation of work. The opening night will be ticketed, featuring DJs, performances, market stalls and interactive art, before the exhibition continues as a public gallery experience.

"A Family Gathering" speaks to the experience, not the theme. It's about bringing artists of Asian heritage into the same room to sit alongside one another and be seen together. Works are open in medium and subject, reflecting the diversity of perspectives across Asian Australian artists.

Artists will exhibit within a salon-style hang, creating a dense and layered presentation of works. A limited number of plinths will be available for ceramic and sculptural pieces.

**We're excited to bring this gathering to Sydney for the first time and to connect with artists across Eora.**

- Artists exploring any subject matter. Works do not need to respond to the title “Family Gathering”

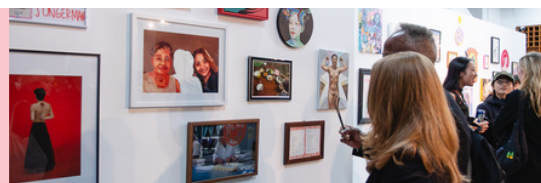
## INSTALLATION NOTES:

Please ensure you're able to

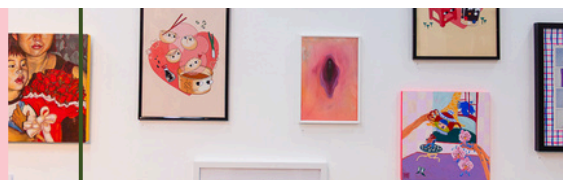
- Deliver works on 11th May to 33 Wellington St, Chippendale. If you aren't able to personally, someone else is able to on your behalf.

# THE SPACE

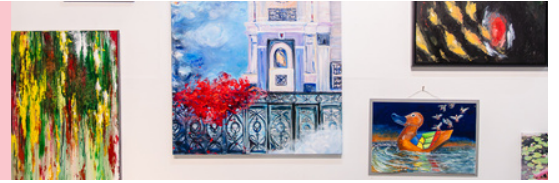


Each artist has the opportunity to

We have a limited number of plinths available, allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If your work requires these or other special installation needs, please include full details in your application so we can confirm availability and feasibility in advance.

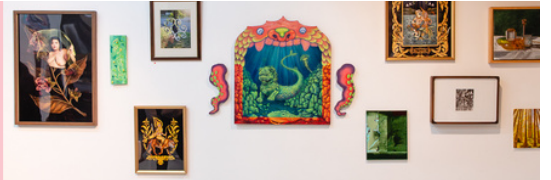
# APPLICATION PROCESS



All proposals must be made via our google form. Please ensure you have prepared the following:

1	<b>A photo of you</b> (used for artist promotion if selected)
2	<b>3 images of past works</b> (including title, year and medium)
3	<b>A Project Proposal</b>  A short proposal outlining the work(s) you'd like to exhibit
4	<b>Up to 10 supporting images</b> (combined into a single PDF). This can include drafts, plans or works in progress.
5	<b>A short artist bio</b> (50-150 words, written in third person)

# WHAT TO KNOW



## Artwork Completion

Your proposed work doesn't need to be complete at the time of application, but should be finished at least two weeks before the exhibition.

## Deadlines

If selected, you'll be sent a follow-up form to collect details about your exhibiting works.

Deadlines include:

### 1. About You + Artist Statement Section

- By Monday 18<sup>th</sup> of May

### 2. Artwork Details + Sale Information + Photos & Drop Off Time

- By Monday, 25<sup>th</sup> of May

## Art Hanging

All hanging works must be install-ready meaning they require a wire or hook for hanging.

If submitting a framed work, please ensure the frame has a secure hanging point and is not fitted with a stand-only backing.

## Art Drop Off

Artists are expected to drop off their work on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June for install. If you are unable to drop off, someone else may do so on your behalf.

## Art Pick Up

Artists are expected to collect their work from the gallery between the 14<sup>th</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> of June.

# ARTIST CONTRIBUTION



A \$45 artist contribution (incl. GST) applies per selected artwork.

This contribution goes towards bringing the exhibition to life, covering venue hire, installation, staffing and opening night production. It allows us to create a shared space for artists to exhibit together as part of Asian Heritage Week. Only selected artists will be required to pay the exhibition fee.

The gallery (not Platform), retains 30% commission on all sold works. We recommend factoring this into your pricing.

# EXHIBITION INCLUSION



Selected artists will receive:

- Placement within a curated salon-style hang
- Opportunity to exhibit alongside a network of Asian artists across Eora/Sydney
- Promotion across Platform's social media channels
- Documentation of the exhibition
- Opportunity to sell work during the exhibition period
- Exhibition install and de-install by our team
- E-newsletter promotion
- Management of all sales during the event
- Opening night event with Djs, market stalls and more

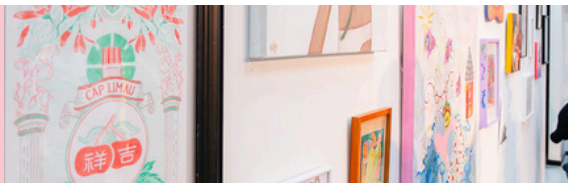
